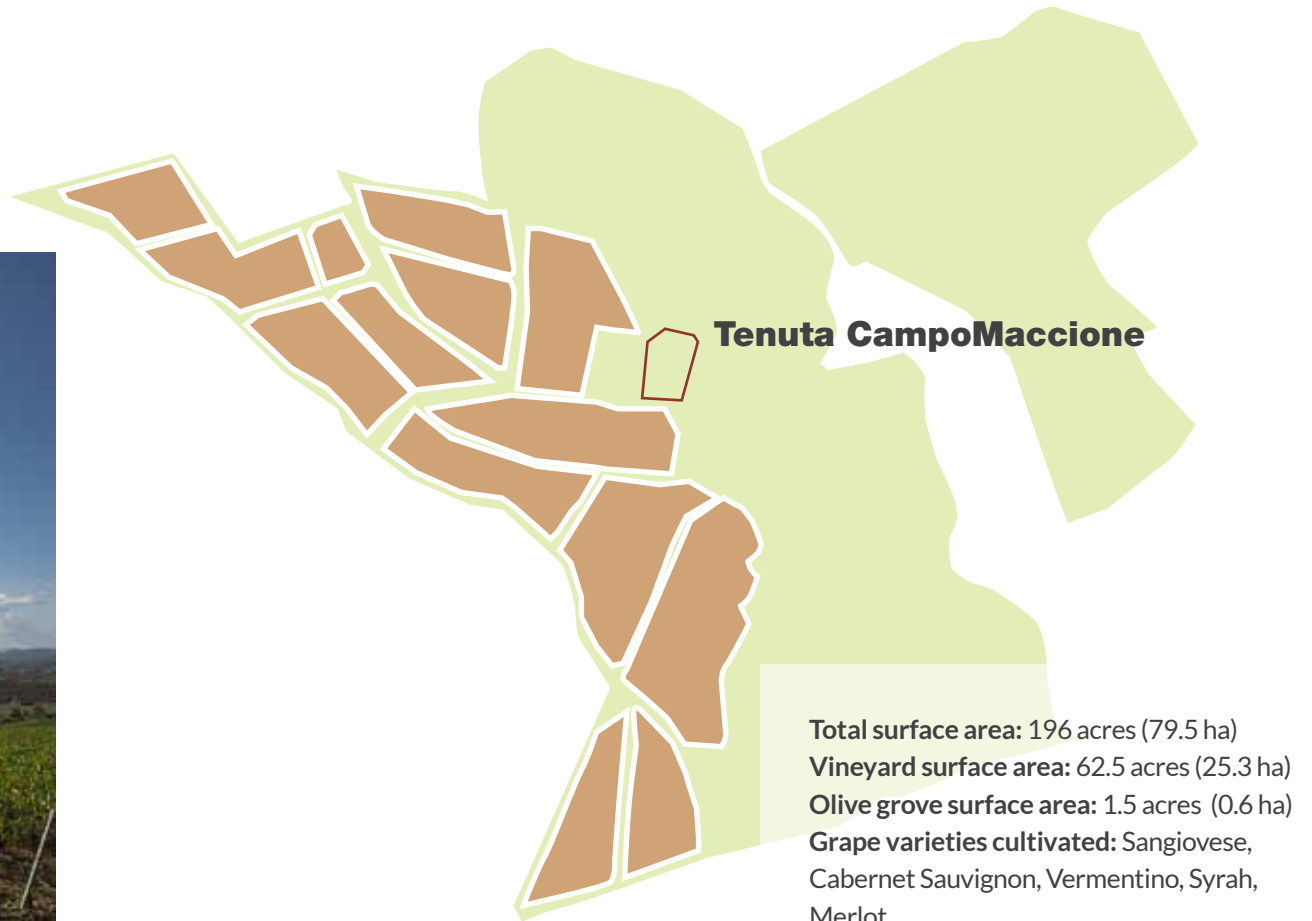




Rocca delle Macie

FAMIGLIA ZINGARELLI



Tenuta CampoMaccione

In 1998, the Zingarelli family, driven by their far-sighted entrepreneurial approach, decided to explore an area where the winemaking tradition has exceptionally ancient roots – the Maremma. Within the DOCG zone of Morellino di Scansano, Rocca delle Macie purchased the 80-hectare (196 acres) Campomaccione estate in order to cultivate Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Syrah grapes with modern planting systems featuring 6000 plants per hectare. The

dry, hilly soils – together with the area’s warm, drought-prone climate – favor the excellent ripening of the grapes, while the brackish sea air is essential for the development of the specific aromatic characteristics that are transferred from the grapes to the wine. This estate gives its name to Morellino di Scansano Campomaccione, Rocca delle Macie’s first wine to come out of the investments it has made in the province of Grosseto. Today the total surface of vineyard is 25

hectares (62 acres).

To give more importance to this reality, Sergio Zingarelli, launched in 2016 the new brand “CampoMaccione - Fattoria di Rocca delle Macie”, and with the 2015 vintage launched three wines (Morellino di Scansano, Rosato and Vermentino) which brings together all the production of the Campomaccione and Casamaria estates.
