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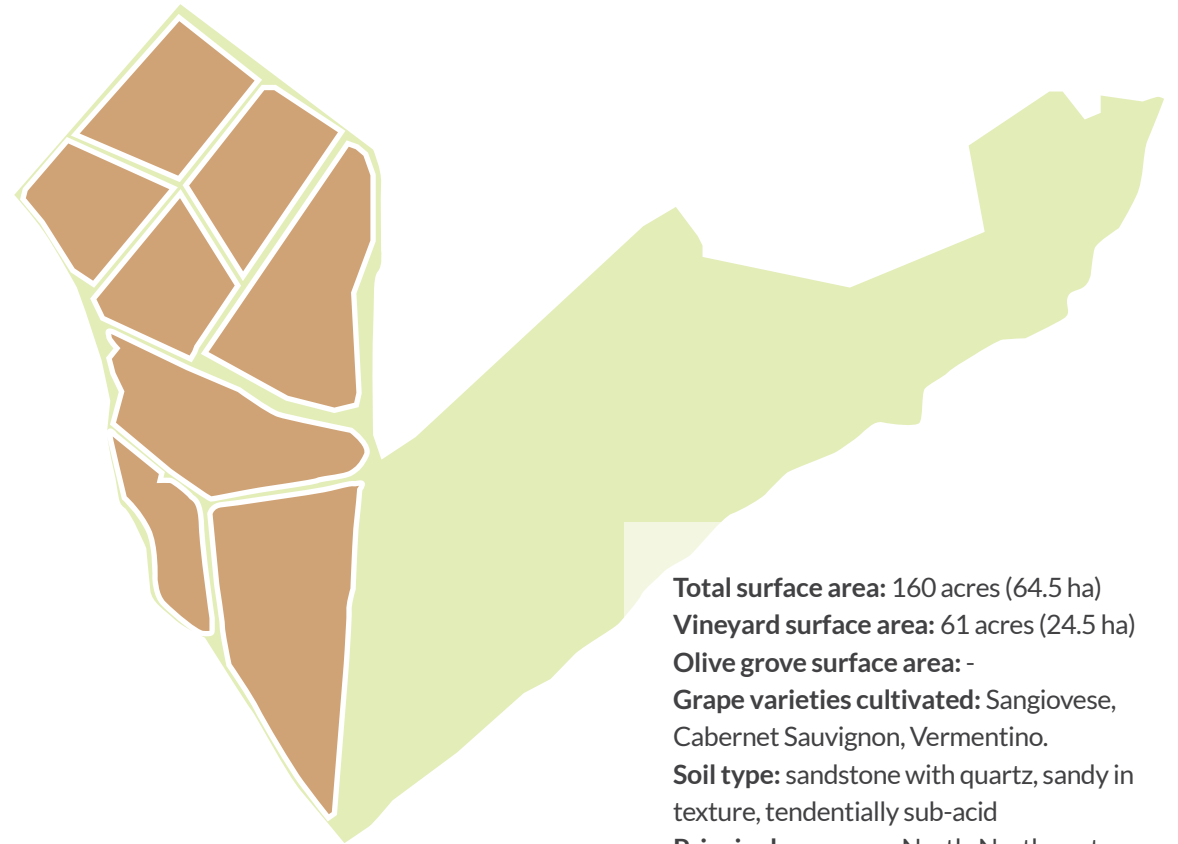


Tenuta Casa Maria

In 2003, Casa Maria Farm was acquired to reinforce Rocca delle Macie's participation in the Maremma area. This 64-hectare (119 acres) farm today has 25 hectares (61 acres) under vine, and was chosen

for the planting of the winery's first Vermentino vineyards, from which the grapes were used to create the second wine produced in this area. This sun-drenched, sea-kissed land has given and will continue to give

great results for Rocca delle Macie, which aims at all times to enhance the quality of its products while respecting the areas in which it operates.
