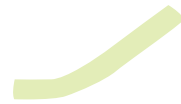

As part of an initiative geared towards enhancing and diversifying the winery's productive base, the Le Tavolelle estate was acquired in 1998 and is composed of 22 hectares (54 acres), of which

5.5 (18 acres) are under vine (mostly Sangiovese). This property plays host to a new cellar for the aging of the prestigious selections of red wines.
